
In summary, the AMGP raised \$54,580 in total revenue from fundraising activities during 2017.

After expenses, AMGP profited \$48,335 in contributions to the girls' scholarship fund.

To compare this to 2016, total revenue was \$45,886 and total profit after expenses was \$36,103. So in summary, there was approximately \$15,000 gain to the scholarship fund over last year.

A record year in fundraising. We hope to have you join us again in 2018!
