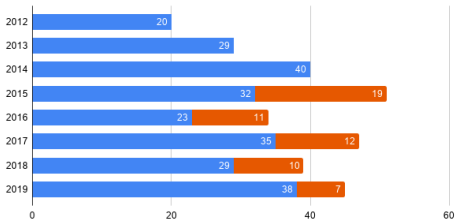

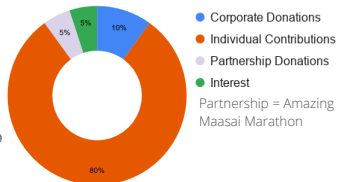

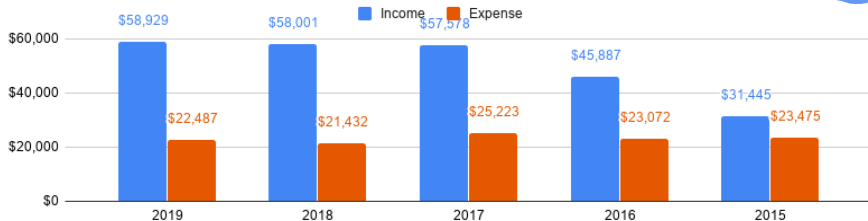

What a wonderful year the Amazing Maasai Girls Project had this year! In August, the Maasai communities of Laikipia Kenya welcomed the 9th year of the Amazing Maasai Marathon and later that fall, our most loyal city captains ran the 6th year of The Global Runs around the world. In 2020, there will be **106 Amazing Girls with 59 high school graduates.**

This year, we raised the **most donations to date** - over \$58,000. A special thanks to our platinum individual sponsors, Marathon Tours participants (in Kenya and Berlin) and Team Dallas, for their excellent fundraising efforts.

Looking ahead, we have **two major initiatives:**

- First, we are aiming to **create an endowment fund** so that future tuition scholarships can be self-sustaining. As noted in our **Five-Year Financial Analysis, we are investing about half of the donations** in long-term investments so that sisters of Amazing Girls will have scholarships for years to come.
- Second, in 2019 we started a **College Fund** open to any and all qualified graduates of the AMGP. Starting January 2020, the fund is providing partial scholarships for 3 former Amazing Girls to attend nursing and teaching college. With a post-secondary education, these women will return to their communities as professionals, mentors and role models for future generations of girls.
