In order to protect the welfare of our 53 sponsored students while schools were closed, the AMGP delivered over \$5,000 in COVID relief for foodstuffs and other living supplies (Mar-Dec 2020).

Our 3 local representatives regularly traveled across the vast rural area of northern Laikipia to visit each girl, providing extra support as needed. 51 girls returned to school in Jan 2021. 3 students fell pregnant during their time at home. We are assisting with pregnancy costs, with the goal of facilitating their return to school.

We thank you from the bottom of our hearts, and on behalf of every Amazing Girl, for your contributions during 2020 to their education and futures. The challenges of the year were unprecedented for all, yet we witnessed unparalleled empathy and generosity.

As of January 2021, **51 Amazing Girls are back**, **safe and supported**, **in school**. First and foremost, our priority is now to support students through the economic challenges that they face as a result of COVID, be it through providing **extra funds for uniforms and study materials or assistance in getting through an unexpected pregnancy**, making sure they return to school after the child is born. Beyond these most pressing matters, we look forward to 15 freshmen entering high school this summer/fall.

With our high school scholarship fund endowment established, we also turn to our graduates, **3 of whom are currently in college**. A further **7 young women are set to graduate** in spring and we will be ready to support their post-secondary education pursuits, so these women can forge careers & be financial contributors to their families
